TIMOTHY J HORNE is authorized to launch a **non-motor support (hybrid)**, noncommercial river trip from Lees Ferry on **Thursday, August 22, 2013** and travel down the Colorado River to **Pearce Ferry**. This is a **standard size** trip.

Important Information

- TIMOTHY J HORNE is the trip leader and **must accompany the entire trip**. This river trip can be transferred to the following Potential Alternate Trip Leader(s): Celeste . Di Iorio. Contact the River Permits Office.
- As trip leader you have the responsibility of ensuring that you and all participants comply with the terms and conditions of the river trip permit as stated in the Noncommercial River Trip Regulations.
- You must bring a copy of the Noncommercial River Trip Regulations and this permit on your river trip.
- You are responsible for hauling your trash out of the canyon and to a proper facility. Trash and garbage may not be left at Lees Ferry, Phantom Ranch, Diamond Creek, or Meadview. Only human waste may be deposited at Meadview's human waste treatment plant.
- River trips exchanging participants or taking out at Diamond Creek must contact the Hualapai River Runners before launch. Call either 928-769-2210 or 800-622-4409. Mailing address is PO Box 246, Peach Springs, AZ, 86434.
- For a standard size trip the maximum number of trip participants at any point within the trip is 16.
- Permit fees are nonrefundable.
- Take-out conditions at the Pearce Ferry ramp change regularly. Due to fluctuating water flows and eroding banks, the space available to derig can vary. Please be flexible.
- This permit is revocable at the discretion of the Superintendent or his authorized representative(s). It is issued based on information provided by the trip leader on their noncommercial river trip permit application.
- Before a river trip may launch or travel in Grand Canyon National Park, a pre-trip inspection and education session must be completed by the Lees Ferry Ranger. **Failure to comply with the Lees Ferry check-in procedures or the Noncommercial River Trip Regulations may result in citation or revocation of this permit.** It is the trip leader's responsibility to be sure all members of the trip are familiar with Lees Ferry camping regulations. Permit not valid without signature from Lees Ferry Ranger.
